



Some newborn screening conditions require urgent interventions; therefore, early identification is critical. Early identification is best achieved with proper, timely specimen collection, and submission.

**Hospital Grading on Unsatisfactory Specimen Collection**

- 0% - .9% = A
- 1% - 1.5% = B
- 1.6% - 2% = C
- 2.1% - 3% = D
- 3% or higher = F

**Hospital Grading on Specimens Received at BPHL - Jacksonville Three Days or More After Collection**

- 0% - 10% = A
- 10.1% - 15% = B
- 15.1% - 20% = C
- 20.1% - 30% = D
- 30.1% or more = F

**Hospital Grading on Reporting CCHD Data**

- 100% - 95% = A
- 94% - 90% = B
- 89% - 85% = C
- 84% - 80% = D
- 79% or less = F
