**Hospital Grading on Specimens Received at BPHL - Jacksonville Three Days or More After Collection**

- A (0% - 10%)
- B (10.1% - 15%)
- C (15.1% - 20%)
- D (20.1% - 30%)
- F (30.1% or more)

**Hospital Grading on Reporting CCHD Data**

- A (100% - 95%)
- B (94% - 90%)
- C (89% - 85%)
- D (84% - 80%)
- F (79% or less)
